



Four lenses. Clearer questions.

EXPERIENCE

What was it like for the person?

An account describes experience; it does not by itself establish its external cause.

MEMORY

How was the account recalled and recorded?

A later interpretation should not silently replace an earlier account.

PHYSIOLOGY

What bodily conditions were documented?

A gap in monitoring remains a gap; it does not establish what happened within it.

RESEARCH QUALITY

What can the investigation support?

A careful investigation can still leave its central question unresolved.

More dimensions of a question, not a higher score. Here, 'higher-dimensional' means holding several distinct perspectives in view. It is an artistic and conceptual metaphor, not a claim about extra physical dimensions.
